Boolean logic: allows you to combine your search terms to either broaden or narrow the retrieval results of a search.

Truncation: allows you to broaden your search by retrieving varying endings of your search terms.

Wildcard: used within a word to search for internal variations of spelling within your search terms.

Phrase searching: allows you to search for an exact phrase using inverted commas.

Proximity searching: allows you to specify the proximity of your search terms. Google's AROUND operator lets you specify how close you want two terms to appear in a web site, replacing "x" with the maximum number of words you want .e.g. obesity AROUND(3) guideline searches for obesity within 3 words from the term guideline.

Field searching: allows you to search for a particular field within the database .e.g. author, title, etc.

Limits: allows you to set parameters in your search resulting in more relevant retrieval.

Thesauri/controlled vocabulary: a set of pre-defined terms assigned by indexers to describe the content of an article.
